The Rotary Club of Tiffin maintains a Foundation to provide funds to worthwhile community projects, with the goal of enriching the lives of others. Rotary focuses on seven areas of emphasis in order to make a difference locally and throughout the world. Those areas are:

- Disease Prevention and Treatment
- Peace and Conflict Resolution
- Clean Water and Sanitation
- Maternal and Child Health
- Basic Education and Literacy
- Economic and Community Development
- Supporting the Environment

Organizations that can demonstrate how their projects will impact one of the above areas will receive greater consideration.

The typical amount awarded ranges from \$250 - \$1,000. However, under special circumstances, more than that amount may be granted. Grant requests are considered on a monthly basis at the Foundation Board meeting, which is held on the second Wednesday of each month.

Organizations may apply by using the form found on the Tiffin Rotary Foundation's website (insert link here). Please complete the application in its entirety. As a requisite for receiving funds, entities must agree to provide the board with a follow-up report, including how funds were spent, and how the project succeeded in meeting its goals as expressed in the application.
